Follow Up From Previous Meeting

- EcoAction funding was denied because the Tree Care team is not distinct enough from existing programing
- Vehicle lease situation is still pending a final decision recommendation is to return to
 Zeemac
- 2017 SNAP budget has been finalized, total City's contribution TBD once CSJ funding is confirmed
- SNAP phones will remain status quo until CSJ funding is confirmed

Past Month

- Our HCTF grant was denied (\$104,975)
 - Not enough explanation of the scientific basis for the work City handles prescriptions
 - o Grant request amount was above the average approved
 - o More feedback and details has been requested
- Meeting with MP Sukh Dhaliwal, phone meeting with MP Randeep Sarai and MP Dianne
 Watts
 - o General support for SNAP, applications have been sent away already
 - o CSJ amounts TBD
